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Drop-off Procedures

Pick-up Procedures

7:30 am–8:15 am Park on the street and drop off at the door with the green awning.	Anytime before camp ends Park on the street and pick-up at the door with the green awning.
8:15 am–8:30 am Use the car line or walk to the door with the green awning. NOTE: NO CAR LINE ON MONDAYS	3:30–4:00 pm Use the car line or walk to the door with the green awning.
8:30 am–until the end of camp Park on the street and drop-off at the door with the green awning.	4:00 pm–6:00 pm Park on the street or in the school's parking lot, and pick-up at the door with the green awning.

PLEASE NOTE: There is no parking at any time of the day or evening in the Union Box and Sanctuary Body Works designated spaces, parking along the side of the north building in the fire zone, or blocking of the Merchant's Point rowhomes garage doors at any time, for any reason, even for a short moment of time. Parking includes occupying the space for any length of time whether someone is in the car or not.

Items must be labeled with first and last name(s), in a 'Ziploc' (or other brand) bag. For preschool campers, please provide an additional bag of under clothes.➤ Preschool Campers: fitted crib sheet and a small cover/blanket.

Lunch and Snacks

If you are not signed up for TNCS's lunch program, please pack a **nut-free lunch** that **does not require refrigeration or heating**. **All items, including your child's lunch bag, containers, and ice packs should to be labeled with first and last name(s)**. Children in elementary programs should pack nut-free snacks from home. Children enrolled in pre-primary and primary camps receive two snacks per day.

ABSOLUTELY NO NUTS, TREE NUTS, OR SHELLFISH ARE ALLOWED AT TNCS DUE TO SEVERE STUDENT ALLERGIES!

Cell Phone Policy

Campers are not permitted to use cell phones or electronic devices during the camp day.
