



TNCS Notice of Non-Discrimination

In compliance with federal and local laws, including Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (“Title VI”), Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (“Title IX”), Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (“ADA”), and the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 (“The Age Act”), The New Century School (“TNCS”) does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, marital status, personal appearance, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, family responsibilities, political affiliation, disability, familial status, or source of income in admissions, employment, or the administration of any of its educational programs and activities.
